Vocabulary to learn

earth	Planet Earth is the planet where we live made of land and sea.
globe	A round ball shaped model of our world showing the land, sea and countries where we live.
space	Beyond our sky there is an area of darkness where planets, stars, meteors and asteroids float around.
moon	A large area of rock that circles our planet earth and we see at night.
planet	Large areas of rock that float in space and orbit around the sun.
environment	The surroundings where a person, plan or animal lives.
recycle	To use things again and re-use rather than throw away.
astronaut	The job of someone who goes into space to find out about our world, the moon and space.
map	A picture from the air looking down showing roads, buildings land and sea.
route	You follow a 'route' to show you how to get to a place or object.
countryside	Land that is not in towns or cities often farmland or woodland
town	A place where many people live in buildings close together with shops, roads and houses
farm	A place where animals or food is grown and looked after usually in the countryside.
spring	A time of the year following winter and before summer where the weather begins to get warmer. The days are get longer.
weather	What it is like outside in terms of rainy, sunny, warm, etc.
bud	The start of a leaf, flower or branch just beginning to grow in spring.
blossom	Flowers that appear on fruit bearing trees in spring before the fruits form.
