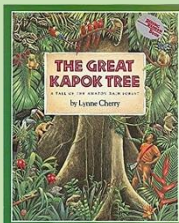
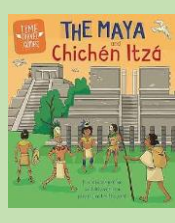

Biodiversity	A wide variety of living things	I know that Brazil is in South America and can locate it on a world map. I know that tropical rainforests are found near the equator, between the Tropics of Cancer and Capricorn. I know that the climate of a rainforest is hot and wet all year round. I know that the four layers of the rainforest are the emergent layer, canopy, understorey and forest floor. I know that plants and animals have adaptations to help them survive in the rainforest. I know that a food chain shows how living things depend on each other for food. I know that the Amazon Rainforest is the largest rainforest in the world and is mostly in Brazil. I know that the Maya were an ancient civilisation who lived in Central America. <u>Focus texts</u>    
Biome	A large, naturally occurring region that has a certain climate and certain types of living things.	
Carbon dioxide	A gas that animals and humans breathe out – plants absorb it	
Climate zone	An area with an unusual temperature, wind, humidity snow or rain in a place	
Deforestation	The destruction of trees over a large area	
Extinct	An animal or plant species that has died out completely	
Habitat	The natural home of an animal or plant	
Adaptation	Something that helps a plant or animal survive in its environment.	
Interdependent	When two or more people or things rely on each other	
Equator	An imaginary line dividing the Earth into northern and southern hemispheres	
Endangered	A species which is seriously at risk of extinction.
