Key Vocabulary

Farming	The activity of growing crops or raising livestock.
Crops	A plant, which is grown on a large scale.
Livestock	Farm animals
Farmer	A person who manages a farm
Healthy	To be in good physical or mental condition.
Herbivore	An animal that only feeds on plants
Omnivore	An animal that eats both plants and meat.
Carnivore	An animal that only eats meat.
Food Chain	A series of living things that depend on the next as a source of food.
Producer	Any kind of plant – they make their own food.
Consumer	A living creature that eats other living things.
Predator	An animal which kills and eats another animal.
Prey	A living thing killed by others for food.
Harvest	A process of gathering crops.
Village	A group of houses and buildings in a rural area.
Poultry	Birds that are farmed such as chickens, turkeys, ducks and geese.
Dairy	Milk and products made from milk.

I can use appropriate tools for food preparation.

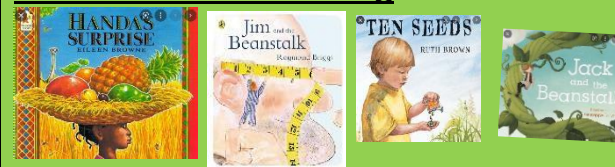
