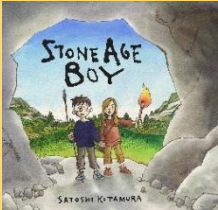

<i>Prehistory</i>	A period before written records	I can say what changes took place from the Stone Age to the Iron Age.
<i>Hunter-gatherer</i>	People who live chiefly by hunting, fishing and harvesting wild food.	
<i>Nomad</i>	People who travel from place to place.	I can compare life in the Neolithic and Bronze Ages.
<i>Palaeolithic</i>	The early stage of the Stone Age	I can say why hillfort settlements were important,
<i>Mesolithic</i>	The middle part of the Stone Age	
<i>Neanderthal</i>	An extinct species of human	I can name and locate counties and cities of the United Kingdom.
<i>Homo sapiens</i>	The species to which all modern human beings belong	
<i>Pelt</i>	Skin of an animal especially with fur or wool.	I can compare and group together different types of rocks.
<i>beaker</i>	People who came to Britain in the Bronze Age	
<i>Celt</i>	A prehistoric stone or metal tool	I can identify physical characteristics, key topographical features.
<i>Bronze</i>	A yellowish-brown metal	
<i>Roundhouse</i>	A circular building	I can identify human geography.
<i>Hillfort</i>	A fort built on top of a hill	
<i>Quern</i>	A hand mill for grinding corn	I can identify land-use patterns.
<i>Smelting</i>	A process for metal that involves heating and melting	
<i>Druid</i>	A priest in the ancient Celtic religion	I can describe in simple forms how fossils are formed.
<i>Borer</i>	A tool for making holes	
<i>Archaeologist</i>	A person who studies history and pre-history through the excavation of sites	<u>Focus Texts and Reading</u>    
<i>Civilisation</i>	A human society with its well- developed social organisations, or culture.	
<i>Warrior</i>	Brave or experienced soldier or fighter	
<i>Artefact</i>	An object made by a human being, one of cultural or historical interest
