Key Vocabulary	
Family	A group of people who together are often related, usually parents and children or grandparents.
Home	A building where people live with their family.
Community	A group of people that share a common link, family, school, Brownies etc.
Past	A time when something has already happened sometimes long ago.
Autumn	A time of the year following summer time and before winter.
Season	The year is split into four seasons, autumn is one of them.
Bare	When plants are 'empty' as the fruit and or leaves have all dropped off.
Thankful	An emotion or feeling that makes us feel nice where we appreciate what we have in life.
Blackberries	An soft fruit you can eat grown in autumn on spikey bushes sometimes in hedgerows.
Conker	A small brown shiny 'nut' with a spikey case fallen from a tree.
Acorn	A very small 'nut' fallen from a tree with a little cap at one end.
Harvest	A Christian celebration to say thanks for all the food farmers have grown.
Vegetables	A plant or part of a plant used as food.
Crops	Plants grown in large fields by farmers for us to eat.
Celebrate	A happy day or time to share with friends or family.
Value	Our Christian 'value' for each term teaches us ways in which we might live our best lives.
Generosity	Being kind and sharing with others, giving some of what you have to those who may have less than you.

I can name and describe people who are familiar to me including friends and family.
