INTENT

Our Vision

Children will develop confidence and responsibility and make the most of their abilities.

They will develop safe, healthy lifestyles.

They will develop good relationships and respect the differences between people.

They will play an active role as citizens.

We recognise the relationship between health and learning and that providing a rich CPSHE curriculum is an investment in both.

Barnwood has nurtured children who respect difference.

Weekly timetabled lessons deliver the explicit CPSHE curriculum. It is the main vehicle for teaching the learning objectives in the Scheme of Work.

This is supplemented with additional time for class councils, circle time, school council, peer mediation etc. Similarly, the time spent responding to day to day incidents is a real context for reinforcing strategies taught in CPSHE.

We use the Cambridge Scheme of Work to provide a framework across the school. The Gloucestershire Pink Curriculum provides further resources including resources to deliver HRE, Drug Education and Basic First aid.

Barnwood has a high quality CPSHE Curriculum that develops children's understanding of themselves and their relationships.

Children will see the universal importance of CPSHE and will confidently and purposefully use their skills to fulfil our school ethos.

Children will see discussion as a powerful communication tool.

They will feel confident in the art of speaking and listening and will be able to identify and understand their own emotions and the feelings of others.

Children understand how their bodies work and how their choices affect healthy lifestyles.

Children understand roles and responsibilities. They develop understanding of their own abilities and how best to develop them.

Barnwood has nurtured children who understand the importance of emotional well-being and good mental health.

A range of activities including role play, drama, discussion and debate allow children to explore difficult issues in a safe environment.

Children will be immersed in rich and varied curriculum. The use of Ground Rules will allow them to explore and understand emotions, healthy lifestyles and mental well-being in a safe and secure environment.
