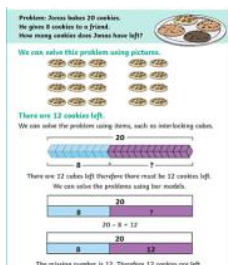


Curriculum

Our work in developing our mastery approach to mathematics has raised standards across the school to be in line and above the national results for 2022. All children have opportunities to use practical resources and make pictorial representations to support their understanding, help them to reason and solve problems and become fluent mathematicians.

Continue to build on the significant improvements we have made in phonics over the last few years.

Our phonics scheme, Read Write Inc, is fully embedded across EYFS & KS1. We have daily phonics sessions in EYFS and KS1 and a focused guided reading session each week.

Our Y1 and Y2 phonics results continue to be in line or above national results.

Writing



Nationally, writing is an area that was impacted during the pandemic.

Like many schools, writing is a priority area for us this year. Our aim is for every child to consider themselves a writer.

To achieve this we have introduced focused guided writing sessions and model writing. We provide first hand experiences to inspire and encourage our children to write as well as providing opportunities for our children to develop their stamina in writing.

Our results for writing in 2022 were above national results.
